

CONSULTATION - ELSTON RECREATIONAL FIELD DEVELOPMENT.

Elston Parish Council is consulting parishioners on a new proposed development of the recreational field on Pinfold Lane.

In March 2022 planning permission was granted for the installation of changing and showering facilities for use by registered sport's clubs.

This has not been progressed and current plans are to now reduce the size of the building by installing a timber framed unit in the style of a 'village pavilion' which is less expensive but will retain all the original features.

This will require the submission of a new planning application as this is a material change to the original plan.

Stage 1: of this initiative is to consult with residents; submit a new planning application; seek permission from our landlord, Notts CC; apply for utilities connections - electricity/water/mains drainage; prepare tender documents; follow through on grant applications and develop a fundraising plan.

Stage 2: will follow dependent on the outcome of stage 1 and include a proposal to publish tender documents and apply for a public works loan.

Stage 3: follows if all the above conditions are considered satisfactory and complete, and Council will decide whether to proceed with the initiative.

To consult locally, a leaflet has been produced outlining the details of the scheme and this will be circulated to all households.
